

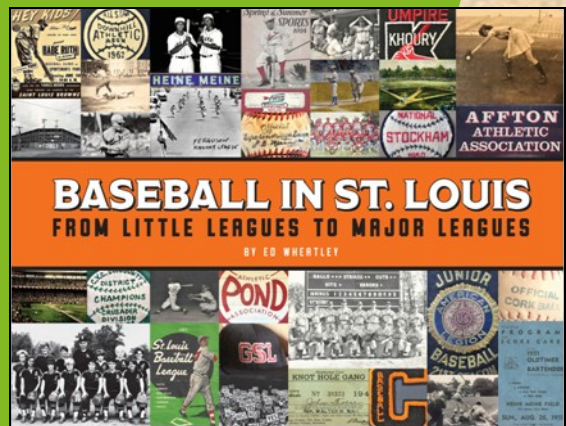
# THIRD TUESDAYS AT THE LIBRARY

Ed Wheatley grew up in and around the world of baseball and continues to play in senior leagues across the country. As the leader of the St. Louis Browns Historical Society & Fan Club, he works to preserve the history and legacy of this transplanted American League team. He regularly speaks on topics of baseball history around the country and has twice had the privilege of speaking at the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown. Ed is the co-author of *St. Louis Browns: The Story of a Beloved Team* and *Incredible Cardinals*, and has been a producer of two award winning St. Louis Browns documentaries that aired on PBS.
